Thank you for your interest in starting a local chapter of the Michigan Masonic Motorcycle Association (M.M.M.A.). The M.M.M.A. has basically done much of the organizational work you will need to get started. The M.M.M.A. is the founding organization of all chapters formed throughout the great State of Michigan. The M.M.M.A. By-Laws have been approved and signed by then, W.G.M. Richard Helmic.

The main concern or obstacle will be getting enough interested brothers to make the commitment; you will need a minimum of six Mason brothers to form a Chapter. Talk to several interested Master Masons in your area who own motorcycles. See if there is enough interest to form a chapter.

M.M.M.A. Association and all Chapter membership requirements are:

- 1) A Master Mason in good standing in a Masonic Lodge approved by the Grand Lodge F.&A.M. of Michigan.
- 2) Ownership of a 500cc or larger motorcycle (any make).
- 3) A valid driver license with a cycle endorsement.

If and when you decide to start a Chapter, submit the completed Chapter application, the initiation fee of \$100.00 (payable to M.M.M.A) and your Chapter by- Laws, after your Chapter by-laws have been approved by the M.M.M.A. at our next meeting, you will be issued a Chapter certificate. You will then, be entitled to all the rights and benefits of the M.M.M.A. and entitled to wear the M.M.M.A. patch and apply your chapter designation rocker below it.

We are not a motorcycle club. We do not claim any territory or have a club house. We are an association of Masonic brothers that enjoy the camaraderie and freedom of riding the open road on a motorcycle with our Masonic Brethren and friends.

The only M.M.M.A. approved web site at www.michiganmma.com is available for all M.M.M.A. Chapters use to publish newsletters, list of officers, chapter applications, rides, events and social functions. The viewing of this site is available to anyone. Please do not hesitate to call on the membership chairman or committee for whatever questions you may have or need of assistance with starting or running your chapter. You will be furnished a packet containing copies of the M.M.M.A. by-laws, constitution, resolutions, materials and guidelines on how to organize your Chapter. We are available to assist you if needed, that you to can enjoy the benefits of this Masonic Association.
